With these agreements, we will strengthen relations between the institutions and we will be able to organize different activities such as: exchange of knowledge between professionals that favors the flow of knowledge and improvement of these technical skills, social skills, and language skills.

We would also like to use these relationships, to be able to participate in innovation projects, both technological and methodological, together with these collaborating Centers and companies, to be able to apply this innovative learning and transmit it to our students, in order to modernize and internationalize CFP BIDEBIETA LHII .

Our Internationalization Plan is part of our Annual Center Plan and also one of the lines we work on in the CIPF BIDEBIETA LHII Strategic Plan.

Said Internationalization Plan has the following lines of work:

- Improve the linguistic, professional and social skills of our students, to open new opportunities in the labor market.
- Improve the professional and linguistic competences of teachers.
- Achieve an increase in the mobility of our students in higher level training cycles to carry out internships in companies, as well as our teachers.
- Get to participate in Innovation projects with our European partners.
- Reinforce the feeling of belonging to Europe, and establish agreements with other member countries through their integration in other forms of life and culture

Both our Internationalization Plan, as well as our Annual Center Plan and Strategic Plan, are aligned with the V Basque Plan for Professional Training of the Ministry of Education of the Basque Country. Specifically, with the strategic area, number 7 of said Plan, which is INTERNATIONALIZATION.
